Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to school for 2017. We have many new students and families across the school and we welcome you to our school and to our community. Parents please support new families as it can be hard work moving towns and starting at a new school. At PPS we are very proud of how all parents support all children – please ensure that while you are supporting and caring for your own child(ren) you are also being respectful and supportive of all children. The staff have worked hard over the holidays and they are enjoying having the children back in class. We welcome Jessica Fry who is our new middle school teacher – please say hello and make her feel welcome. A special thank you to Luke Munn who has worked very hard over the holidays in the school gardens. – They look fantastic. A summary of our staff members is included later in this newsletter.



#### Safety To and From School

Tyler in grade 1 was very excited to be riding his new bike to school on Wednesday. He was well supported by his brothers Mitchell, Ryleigh and Big Tom. Well done boys.

Please make sure that your child is aware of their to and from school routines. If they are biking or walking to school without an adult – please make sure that they are aware of hazards such as the road and that they have the skills to complete the journey safely.

Please – check childrens' bikes are up to standard and that a fitted helmet is worn every time a child rides a bike, scooter or other to school. Children not wearing helmets will be asked not to ride to school.

#### **Absences**

Like every school in the state we must record who is absent from school. If your child will be absent then please send a note to your child's teacher or call the school office.

If a child is absent and we have not been notified – Liz will call you. This call is not about why they are away – it is simply about keeping all of our children safe. At PPS the student roll is taken at 9.05am – absences are sent to Liz in the office and she calls the contact adult of any child who is absent without notification to ensure that every child who left home to come to school that morning – made it to school that morning. This is particularly important for children who walk or bike to school.

#### Nuts at School – and not just the staff!

Anaphylaxis is a medical condition that is taken very seriously by the Department of Education under advice from the Department of Health and as such Ministerial Orders are in place to help protect and support school children who are anaphylactic.

At PPS we have a junior student who has an anaphylactic reaction to nuts that is potentially life threatening. Children with Anaphylaxis will have a specific plan to support them with how to learn to manage this day to day. While young children are learning to self manage, schools are asked to support them and put actions in place to help prevent the chance of an anaphylactic reaction occurring.

For this reason students at PPS are asked not to bring along peanuts or cashew nuts to school in their lunch boxes. The parents of the child we are supporting have informed me that many items you would buy in the super market for children's lunches state that this product "may contain traces of nuuts". These products are ok in this case – it is the actual peanuts and cashews that we are asking families to leave in the cupboard at home.

While many children do love peanuts and cashew nuts — these are not to be brought to school please. Thankyou for your support with this.

#### **Swimming Lessons and Open Water Swim Program**


