The 2018 preps this week are focused on the letter B, looking at different shapes and have had a P.E. session with their buddies. The Grade 1/2's are working hard at handwriting and did a KWL (know, want to know, and learnt) for a reading activity. The Grade 3/4's are developing their Growth Mindset and NAPLAN style literacy activities. The Grade 5/6's are advancing their writing skills with A-Z writing and learning coding in the pod. The Year 7's participated in a Learning Pit challenge about dreams.

Unicorns lost to Magic 4-28

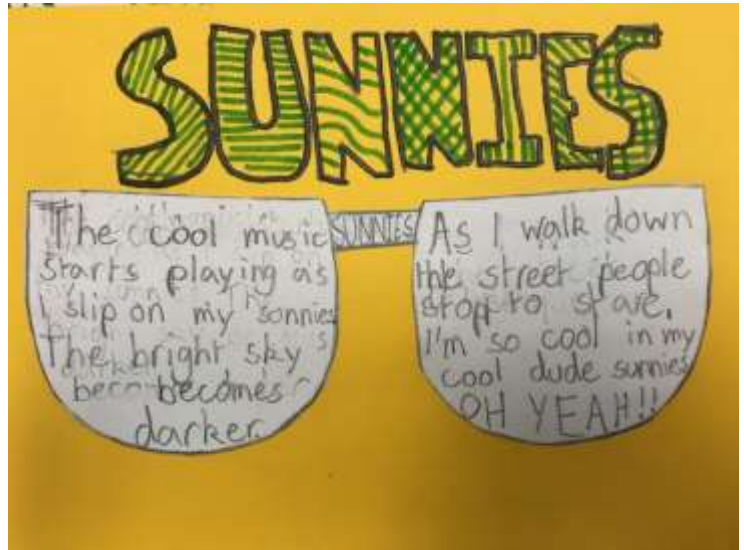

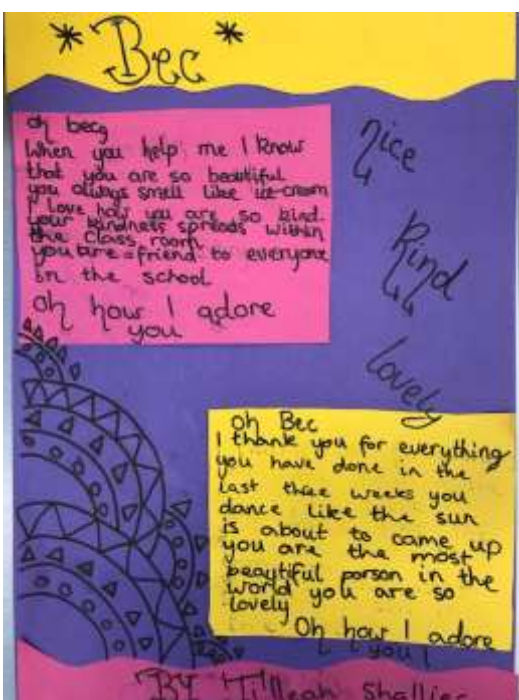


Limerick- Ellie Roberts Gr 5

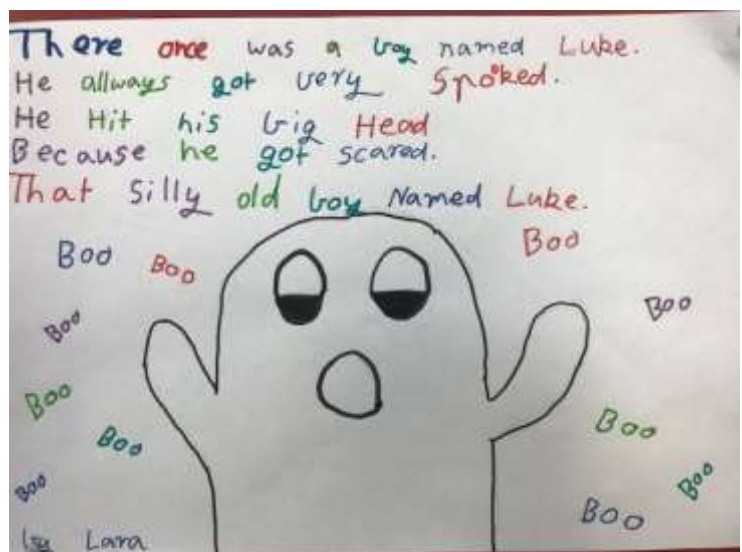

You're the hair to my moustache


You're the Queen of Egypt, you will be mine forever
