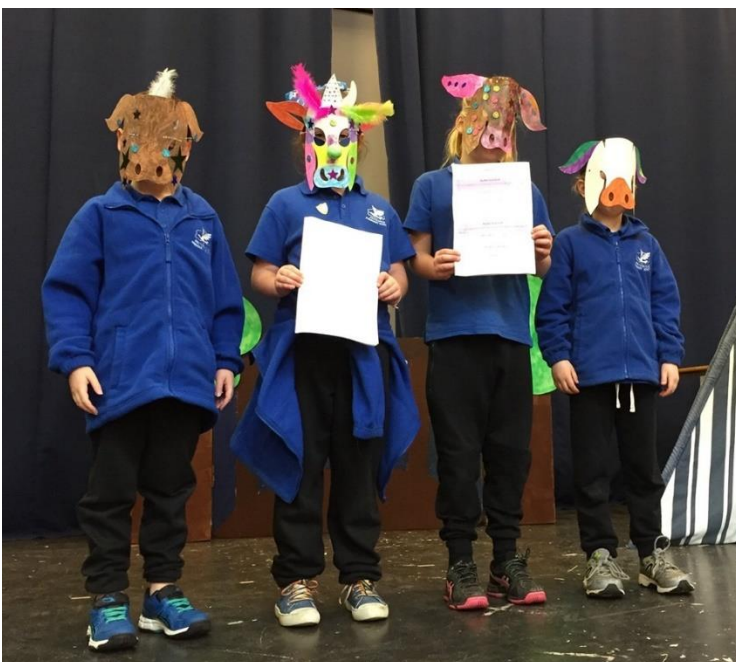






Grade 1/2 Plays

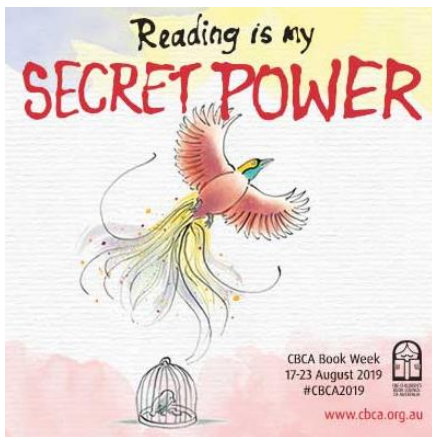
