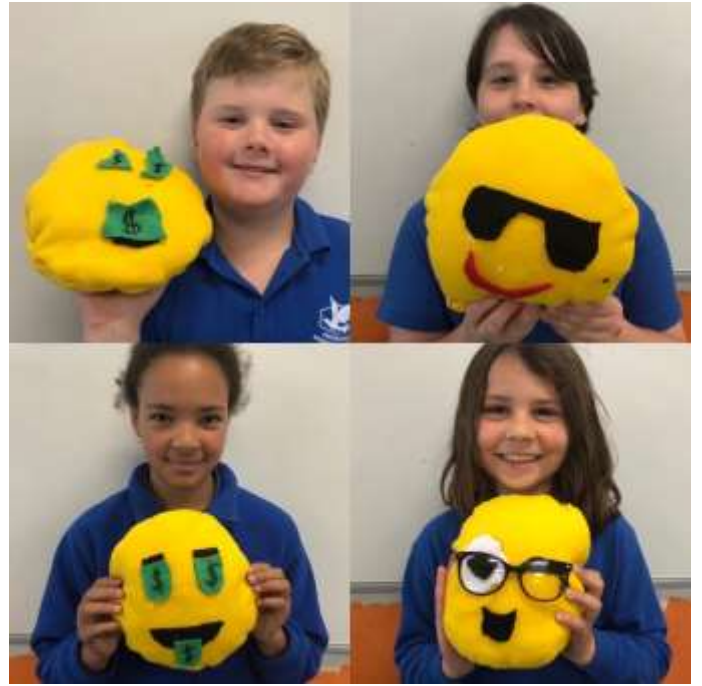
UNSW ICAS Assessments

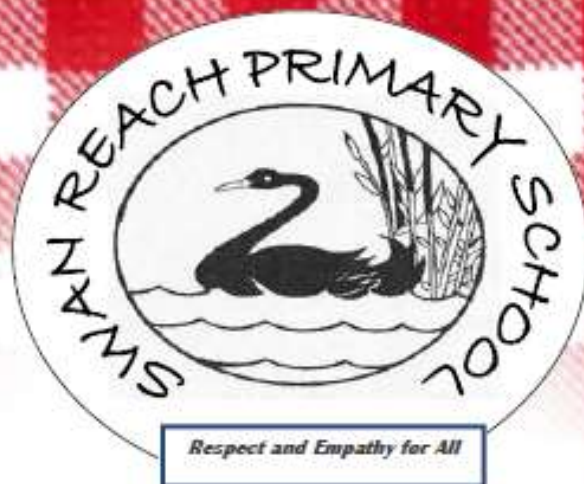
