2 Square Tournament

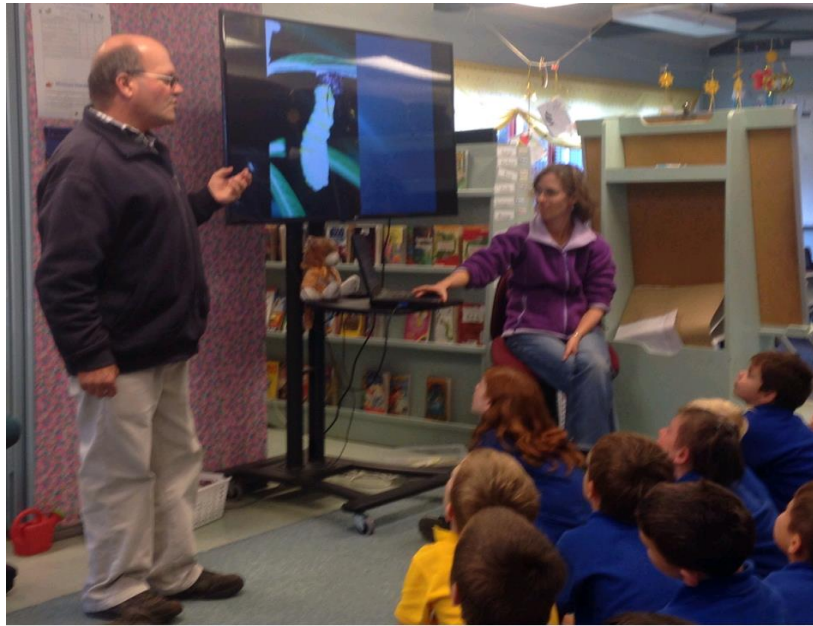

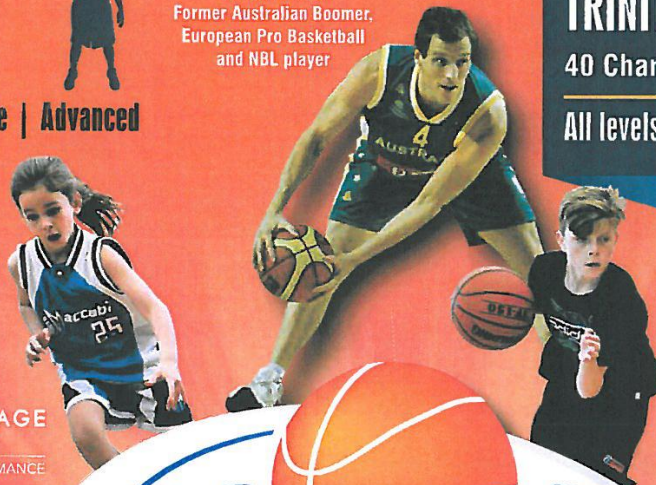

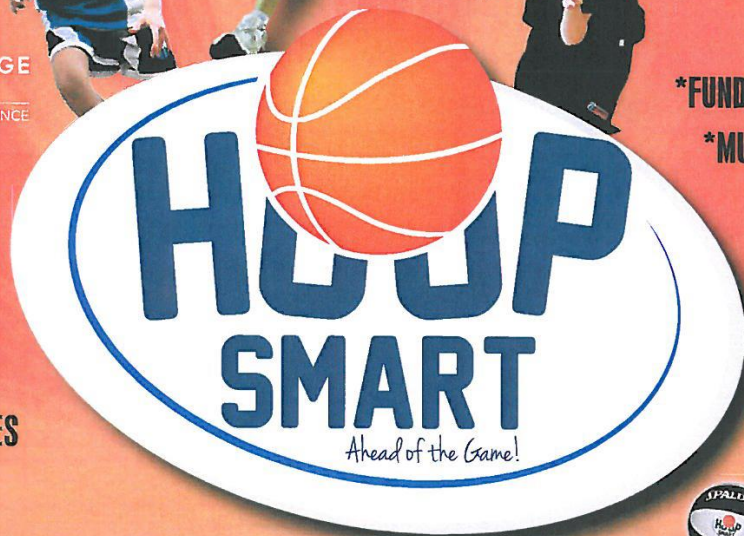
