Cartooning Workshops at East Gippsland Art Gallery

Saturday 22 August 2015

To coincide with the *Cartoons from Cuba* exhibition currently showing at East Gippsland Art Gallery in Bairnsdale, two workshops will be conducted at the gallery on Saturday 22 August.

The workshop tutor, James O'Connell, taught English and History for 28 years and often included his cartoons in his teaching.

O'Connell's cartoons first appeared in educational publications such as *Challenge* and *Pursuit*. He has been drawing the *Mick and Hoppa* comic strip since the 1980s. It was published briefly in *Happiness for life* magazine and the *Footscray Times*. It appeared in the *Gippslander* from 2013 to late 2014 and will reappear there in September this year as an ongoing strip. James also has a blog called *Joc's Cartoons*.

Originally the main inspiration for the cartoons was James' long holidays hitching and cycling in Australia and America. Added to this are observations about popular culture and world affairs. Basically, his characters are Aussies who are a little like the 'Two Stooges' and they travel to all sorts of locations, even the Moon.

James has made a lot of use of his travel diaries, photos and postcards as content material. This is one area he will explore in the workshop: where to get inspiration from and how to exaggerate.

The content of the workshop will include caricature, picture and cartoon strip composition and use of dialogue balloons, as well as inspiration for humour.

The workshops will run from 10am to 12noon for primary aged children and from 12.30pm to 2.30 pm for secondary aged students and will be held at the East Gippsland Art Gallery in Nicholson Street, Bairnsdale.

The workshop fee is \$20pp and bookings are essential. The workshop materials list is available from the gallery.

The exhibition *Cartoons from Cuba* and cartooning workshops have been made possible through assistance from an Arts and Heritage Alliance Grant from East Gippsland Shire Council.
