
Parent volunteer request. There are still a few places available if you can help. There is a roster on the front desk at the office "HELP!"





GLYC Discover Sailing Training and Events

The Discover Sailing Courses provide an opportunity for people of all backgrounds, ages, and abilities to find out how fun, safe, accessible, and affordable sailing is. This year our sailing school course runs from November to December, with a number of extension programs and events planned for the rest of the sailing season (to Easter)

Sunday 26 October Discover Sailing Day (including Sailing School registration)

Sunday 23 November Sailing School Session 3

Sunday 14 December Sailing School Session 6

Sunday 21 December Sailing School Session 7 (Christmas party and fun day)

As an extension to the Discover Sailing program, this year GLYC is organising a number of other programs/events with the primary aim of getting more kids sailing out on our waters. These include:

- Friday night, family night: across daylight saving families are invited down to the clubrooms on Friday night. BYO dinner (BBQ available), with drinks available from the club. Weather pending we might even go for a twilight social sail.
- Tackers 1 and 2: The Boatshed program will again be visiting GLYC in the summer school holidays (4-8 January). Registration details to be made available closer to the date.
- Division E Sailing: starting in the new year Division E provides green fleet racing and coaching for juniors as part of the GLYC race calendar
- *Division Cool Sailing*: also starting in the new year Division Cool, (combined with Division E Sailing) provides identified sailors with the opportunity to extend their skills learnt at Sailing School. A more informal training session, young sailors are provided with guidance and support to take the next step in their sailing.
- Good Friday Appeal Raymond Island Sail: after successfully raising \$1500+ for the Royal Children's Hospital Appeal last year, the kids are planning to do it again... (more details to follow closer to the date)

Discover Sailing Day

Discover Sailing Days are offered for FREE at many sailing clubs around Australia. They are a fantastic way to have a great day out with your partner, friends, work colleagues or family. Clubs look forward to showing you just how fun, safe, accessible, and affordable sailing is.

GLYC's Discover Sailing Day is being held Sunday 26 October, from 9am to 12noon. A number of our members will be available at the club and there will be opportunities to join them for a sail (weather pending). About Discover Sailing Courses

Discover Sailing Courses offer a structured way to learn to sail for people new to the sport, or having basic skills that they wish to develop. You can register for a Discover Sailing Course with no prior sailing experience or you may have already had an opportunity to get out on the water through participating in a Discover Sailing Day.

The 2014 course information relevant to Gippsland Lakes Yacht Club Discover Sailing Centre is outlined below:

- We will offer training this year for relatively unexperienced juniors and teens (8-15 years). Start Sailing 1 and Start Sailing 2 will run in parallel, and which stream will depend on the prior experience of the student.
- There will be 6 x 3.5 hour (nominal) sessions, all before Christmas.
- Including preparation and clean up time, and a BBQ (with parent assistance), we will run from 09:00 to 12:30 on Sunday mornings.
- The cost of the course will be:
 - o \$150 for first year sailing school students (includes Discover Sailing Pack)
 - o \$120 for returning second year students

Discounts are available for additional family members. This fee is primarily just to cover the costs incurred by the Club in running these courses, all time input is voluntary.

- Registration will be held in conjunction with our Discover Sailing Day on Sunday 26 October. Students can be signed up from 10am, with preliminary information to be provided at the sailing school information session / briefing at 11am. For those keen there will also be opportunity to go out for a sail with one of our club members.
- Classes will commence on Sunday 9 November, and will run through to Sunday 21 December.
- One clear prerequisite for any student is that they be confident and competent in the water, and session 1 will involve a test of this.
